

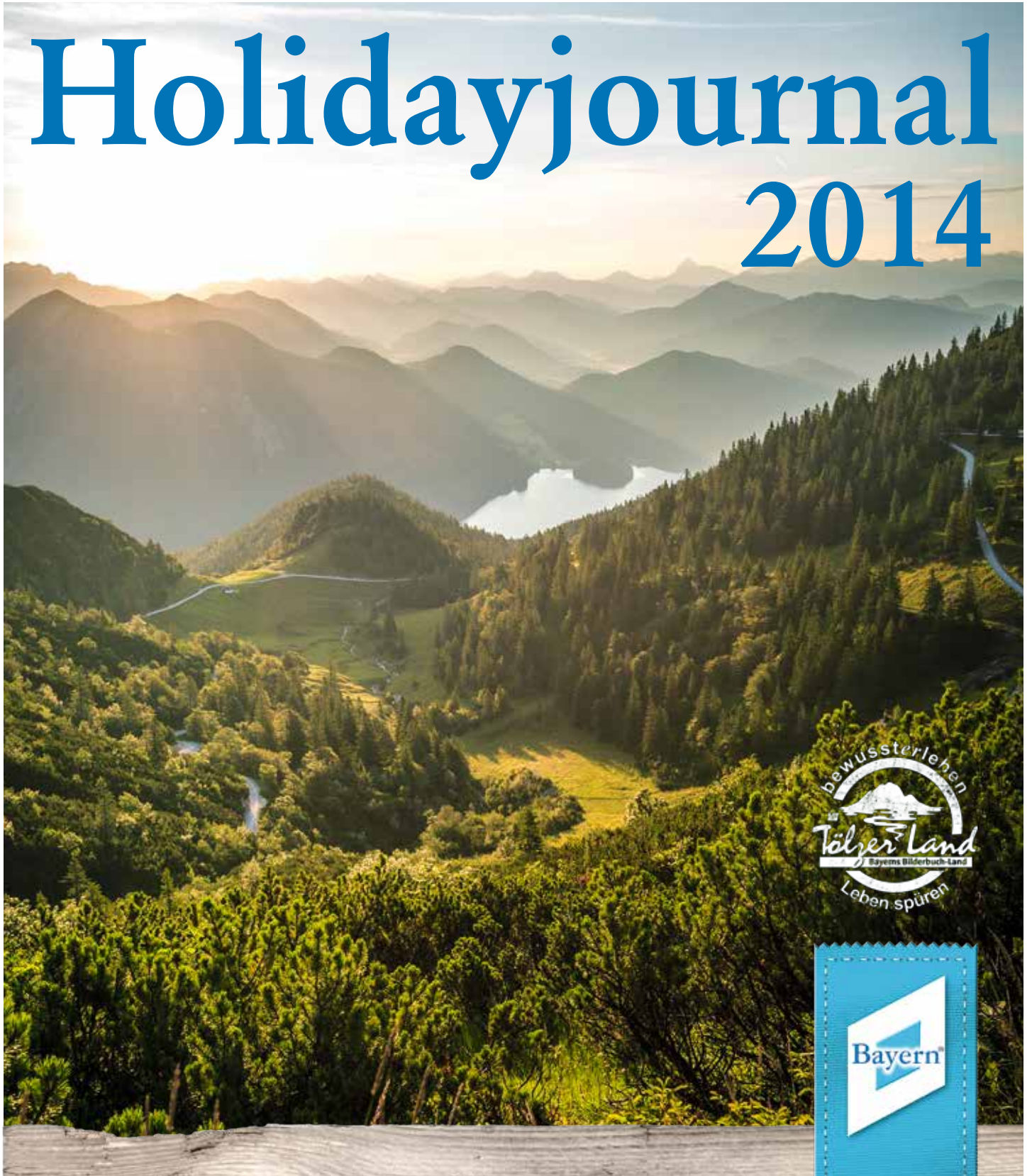

Get your children enthusiastic about cycling and hiking. You reach Schlehdorf by taking the rock path right on the banks of Kochelsee lake – and return by ship. Or you can climb up the Altlicher Hochkopf (1328 metres) by the Walchenseelake in 1½ hours with the promise of a good snack in your rucksack.

One part of the original film coulisse „Wickie und die starken Männer“ and „Wickie auf großer Fahrt“ is positioned in Walchensee for visiting. Sights around the lakes

FRANZ MARC MUSEUM

Kochel a. See · Our landscape as an inspiration for an entire epoch, for the beginning of expressionism in the early 20th century. Famous artists, such as Kandinsky, Macke, Münter, Klee and, of course, Franz Marc, worked here. The museum displays a large collection of paintings, drawings and woodcuts for Environment and Culture.

WALCHENSEE MUSEUM

Walchensee · It contains not only paintings by local artists but also works of the painter Lovis Corinth. At the beginning of the 20th century he lived in Urfeld and there produced the notable Walchensee pictures.

WALCHENSEE POWER STATION

Walchensee · The Power Station, which came on stream in 1924, supplies around 300 million kilowatt hours of environmentally friendly energy each year. It is one of the largest high-pressure storage power stations in Germany. A modern information centre explains very clearly how hydroelectric power is produced.

KRISTALL TRIMINI POOL

Kochel a. See · This is the ultimate pool for the whole family. Bathing in all its forms: inside and outside, heated or refreshing, kneipp hydrotherapy, splashing and spraying and whizzing.

HERZOGSTAND CABLE RAILWAY

Walchensee · Enjoy a trip up the mountain with a unique view of Walchensee lake and the majestic Alpine setting. From the top terminal there are beautiful short paths to the peak and the mountain restaurant. Or, if you are feeling ambitious, take a walk along the demanding mountain ridge to Heimgarten.

OPENAIR MUSEUM GLENTLEITEN

A different kind of museum, where farmers' and craftsmen's beautiful old houses have been brought together and picturesquely rebuilt. Events and exhibitions convey how our forefathers lived, and craftsmen present occupations that died out long ago.

Places of excursions

BENEDIKTBEUERN

The oldest monastery in Upper Bavaria is today home to a university and the Centre for Environment and Culture.

BAD TÖLZ

In the foothills of the Alps has a very fine-historical centre with an attractive Market-Street and the famous murals, the „Lüftmalereien“, on the outside of the houses.

MURNAU

As in Kochel a. See, you can follow up the traces of the „Blauer Reiter“ in the Castle Museum and the Münter House. An attractive pedestrian precinct.

GARMISCH

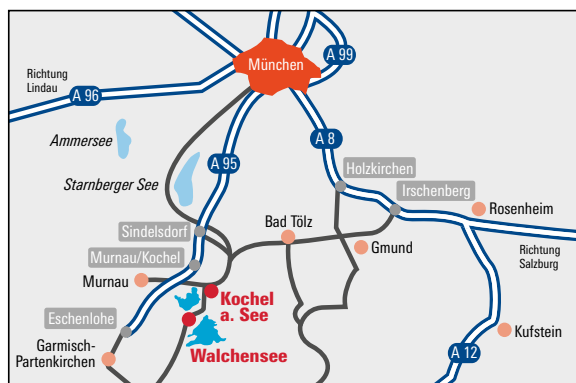
Once the venue of the Olympic Winter Games, is the Germany winter sportscentre at the foot of Germany's highest mountain, the Zugspitze.

MUNICH

The capital of Bavaria with its many attractions, is a good one hour's drive from us. Enjoy a sightseeing tour through Munich.

LINDERHOF PALACE

King Ludwig II's rococo palace in a spacious and beautiful park, not far from Oberammergau.



HOW TO GET HERE BY CAR:

From the A 95 motorway, take the Murnau/Kochel exit, then follow the signs first to Kochel a. See and from there to Walchensee. From the A 8 Motorway, take the Holzkirchen exit (when coming from Munich) or the Irschenberg exit (when coming from Salzburg or Kufstein for instance) and take the B 472 road to Bichl via Bad Tölz, then turn left onto the B 11 to Kochel a. See via Benediktbeuern before proceeding over the pass to Walchensee.

HOW TO GET HERE BY TRAIN:

Take the train from Munich to Kochel (changing trains in Tutzing). There is a regular bus service between Kochel a. See train station and Walchensee.
